Draw a hero or heroine with a brief description about them and their talents or powers.

Write a legend poem or saga – this could be created by a group of children and performed at an event.

Create a new recipe linked to a particular story and make this for an event, taking photos!

We invite book groups and anyone interested in joining in, to send a copy of the winning entry from any competition they wish to organise on the GNSSM theme, to co-ordinator, Louise Stothard, by the end of June 2018.

We will then choose overall winners and award prizes.
