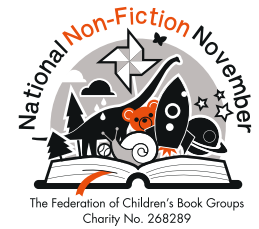


THE WORLD AROUND US Activity Pack

Why not try this extra activity from *Forest Life and Woodland Creatures*?

MAKE A BEAR MASK

You will need:

- Paper plates (2 per mask)
- PVS glue
- Scissors
- Black marker pen
- Brown tissue paper
- Sticky tape
- Paintbrush
- A short stick



- Cut a third off the paper plate, then cut out a circle and 2 ear shapes from the other plate.
- Tear the brown paper into little pieces and glue them on the paper plate and ears.
- Ask an adult to cut two holes for eyes.
- Draw a nose and mouth on the circle using marker pen. Then colour in a black patch on each ear.
- Glue the circle onto your mask leaving a little bit sticking out at the bottom.
- Turn the mask over and tape the top of the stick to one side. Now you can try on your mask!
