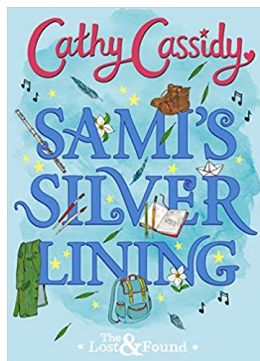




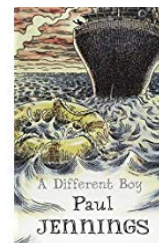
## National Share a Story Month 2019 – Travelling Tales

Some recent books that have caught my eye! And these are only a few of the very many available...

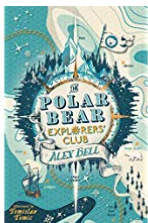

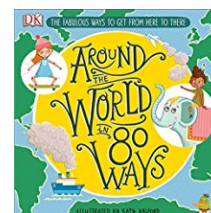


*Nell and the Circus of Dreams* by Nell Gifford OUP – a dreamlike journey into the life of the circus follows Nell finding a chick.



*Little Bird Flies* by Karen McCrombie Nosy Crow – Little Bird dreams of leaving her Scottish homelands to travel to America

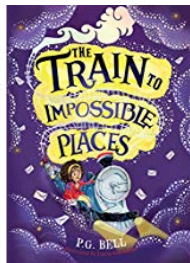
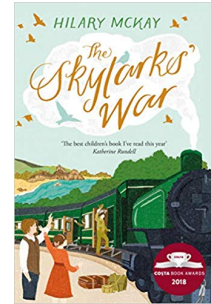
*Around the World in 80 Ways* by DK and Katy Halford DK – 80 fun and original ways to travel the globe.





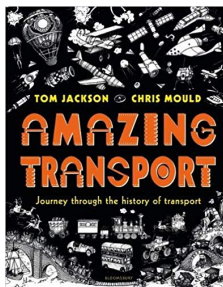
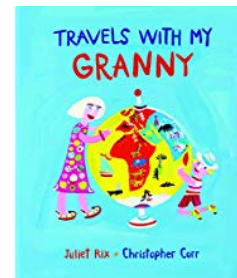
